Mr. Peek was a voting member on the \$1.5 billion State Small Business Credit Initiative (SSBCI), and an observer on Investment Committees representing Secretary Geithner and the Deputy Assistant Secretary on the \$30 billion Small Business Lending Fund (SBLF) and a voting member on the \$300 million CDFI Lending Fund.

Those activities resulted in investing in nearly 500 community banks, CDFIs, and Credit Unions, 50 US States and Territories. The activities created revolving loan funds, venture capital funds, and loan guarantee funds resulting in over \$15 billion in economic impact and access to capital. Those activities saved or created more than \$250,000 jobs.

He was appointed to be a voting member on the Director Selection Committee whose role was to appoint exceptional U.S. citizens as board members for the United States to TARP bank recipients. Mr. Peek represented the US. Treasury on the Presidential Task Force for Veterans Access to Capital .
